2006 to early 2007 was a time of major change in the child care market with 14 full day centers closing while others opened. This period saw the largest shift in ownership in full day centers in the past decade. It is not known how much of the 3% is a temporary change caused by these shifts in group centers and how much reflects a change in how parents chose to care for their children. Similar changes also occurred in after school care with several sites closing and the loss of a number of before school programs. One untracked variable in school age care is the use of community center and other programs that are not state regulated. Drops in use of regulated school age care are often shifts to more informal community programs which are not tracked by the 4-C survey. The shift in part day preschools does not reflect closure of programs as much as the shifting of categories. A number of part day programs saw an increase in parents using them as full day options through using multiple part day classes with wraparound care at these programs. When the number of children meeting a full day attendance classification increases beyond a specific level, the center is shifted to a full day classification as part of the rates survey. The drop in part day preschool attendance above mainly reflects that categorical shift.

Even with the large increase in infant toddler enrollment the market is far short of the capacity it needs to address the increased birth rate in Dane County.

Wisconsin Shares Child Care Market

The charts show the breakdown and rate of change in the use of Wisconsin Shares child care subsidies between March 2006 and March 2007. The data is analyzed both geographically and by type of program.

March is probably too early to tell to what extent changes in the subsidy laws have affected programs willingness to accept children. The drop in the number of children served by city accredited family child care could reflect the major increase in funds in the City of Madison subsidy system which serves low income families excluded from the state subsidy system. The city subsidy system has rates based on accredited rates and thus is a better system for accredited programs as it pays closer to the full cost of care.

While only 12% of the full day group centers do not serve at least one Wisconsin Shares child, none of the part day preschools and a significant portion of the family childcare programs did not have any Shares children attending in March of 2007. Here is a chart by regulation of what percentage of family child care homes did not have any Shares children.

Given the numbers of programs with very few children whose care is paid for by Wisconsin Shares, a significant number of programs are either not or very minimally involved with the subsidy program in spite of the fact that it probably pays for about 20% of the children enrolled in care.

The final chart shows where the children receiving Shares subsidies live and where they are in care. Analysis shows that about half of the children are in care in their own zip codes and about half are not. The variance is the same whether the family uses group centers or family child care.
