DANE COUNTY

65% percent of the licensed family child care homes; 57% of the certified and 39% of the provisionally certified returned surveys. Percentages in brackets after the rates indicate rate of change since 2006. City accredited homes are those homes inside and outside of Madison accredited by Satellite. The highest weekly rates in the ranges often reflect top rates on sliding fee scales or rates used by providers mainly doing part-time care. The first line in each rate category is the number of homes using that rate. Hourly rates are for part-time care. Data is not included in the rate calculations for homes that only serve children on Wisconsin Shares subsidies and use the maximum payment rate from the state.
