Child Care Supply: Survey data was not complete enough to do a report based on total enrollments so regulated slots (each slot being space for one full time child) were used to identify the capacity and market share for each type of program or zip code in the county. The number of children receiving Wisconsin Shares child care subsidies is based on reports from the state's child care billing system for March 2013.
