



WALWORTH COUNTY EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND CHILD CARE REPORT 2013

Child Care Supply: Survey data was not complete enough to do a report based on total enrollments so regulated slots (each slot being a full time space for one child) were used to identify the capacity and market share for each type of program or zip code in the county. The number of children receiving Wisconsin Shares child care subsidies is based on reports from the state's child care billing system for March 2013. The number of available slots decreased by 112 as the county again lost regulated child care slots suggesting a tight child care market with a number of rural areas having no regulated care at all. Seven percent of the children receiving child care subsidies are in zip codes with no regulated care.

Walworth County family child care providers have been in business for an average of 14 years. One has a CDA and six have infant toddler credentials. Another three have school age credentials. Three have preschool certificates and eight have other credentials.
