

DODGE COUNTY EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND CHILD CARE REPORT 2015

Child Care Supply: Regulated slots (each slot being space for one child) were used to identify the capacity and market share for each program type or zip code in the county. The number of children receiving Wisconsin Shares child care subsidies is based on reports from the state's child care billing system for March 2015. 61 children on Wisconsin Shares are in care outside Dodge County.
