

When public water is not available, a certified provider is required to have the water tested and found to be **bacteriologically safe** and to have **safe nitrate levels** by a laboratory certified under 42 CFR 493 (CLIA). A well water test is mandatory prior to initial certification and at least every 2 years thereafter. The following is a list of labs that can conduct well water testing.
