2023 Average Wages, Benefits, & Staffing Grant, lowa & Lafayette Counties Group Center Child Care



- Data was combined for the counties of Grant, Iowa, & Lafayette due to the low number of group programs in these counties as well a low return rate for individual counties.
- Group programs include regulated group centers, school age programs, preschools, camps, and Head Start programs.
- All responses were gathered electronically and submitted directly from each program.
- Responses are based on approximately 43% return rate.

Methodology and Definitions

- Many of the positions had a wide range in their minimum and maximum wages.
- An average and median wage value was included for all positions.
- Average data can generally give a good representation of data.
 - However, when using averages, adding one extreme value can pull the average up or down and therefore may give a misrepresentation.
- **Median** values are the exact middle of the range and are another tool to evaluate the data.
- Each staff position duties and responsibilities tend to vary for each program.
- The Department of Children and Families *licensing rules* will indicate entry level training that is approved for child care workers. This can be found here.
- Wages are listed as the amount paid per hour

Key Findings

78% indicated they had child care vacancies in their program because they could not hire staff to work in those rooms.

57% indicated they had entire classrooms empty because they could not hire staff.


212 children had to be turned away because program classrooms were closed due to staffing shortages.











Average Wages, Benefits, & Staffing Survey Comments and Concerns

4-C received feedback from group child care programs that the unused capacity in programs was the result of an inability of centers to hire qualified staff as opposed to a lack of demand.

Additional questions were asked in the survey to address these concerns.

- All classrooms are being utilized but we could have more children attend if we could hire more staff to make some classrooms with 2 staff in them.
- Our staff do not get benefits. We have tried hard to raise our wages but we often loose staff to higher paying jobs with benefits.
- Due to the **Child Care Counts program** we are able to give our staff a significant wage increase \$1 \$2 per hour.
- It is hard to keep staff because of the wages and no benefits. the building is not big enough to hold all the kids that want to enroll.
- It is beyond a crisis at this point. I am
 considering closing the center down and using
 the building in a different way. The stress of not
 having quality help is really taking a toll on me. I
 am to the point I no longer enjoy operating the
 center. SOS

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
