#### Ages and Stages Questionnaire

The **ASQ** is an age-based developmental screening tool that guides parents in observing their child and completing a simple questionnaire. The information gathered helps parents understand their child's strengths and areas where they may need additional support.

### Child and Adult Care Food Program

Through the CACFP we assist Family Child Care providers to receive reimbursement for serving healthy meals. This federally funded program is sponsored by the United States Department of Agriculture.

### Behavior Help Wisconsin

BHW assists early childhood care and education providers feeling challenged by the behavior of a child. We deliver one-on-one coaching so you can have the tools, knowledge, and skills to reduce challenging behaviors and promote positive ones in your program.

4-C works with businesses and realtors who are looking to support their employees and clients by providing families with pre-screened child care provider profiles containing details regarding each program's openings, cost of care, and any additional information requested.

While standard referrals are free for all families. Enhanced Child Care Referrals help streamline the process of finding care for a nominal fee paid by an employer or realtor. Businesses who have offered this service as a perk report lower staff turnover, improved morale, and reduced absenteeism.
